

# CAMP MOSHAVA - CLOTHING AND PACKING LIST

## Weekdays

6 pair long pants  
10 pair shorts (girls' shorts must be knee-length while sitting)  
6 long sleeve shirts  
4 sweatshirts  
12 short sleeve shirts  
14 pair socks  
1 cap or hat (mandatory)  
1 raincoat or poncho  
1 pair shower clogs  
1 sweater  
3 bathing suits  
(no 2-piece suits)  
3 pair light pajamas

2 pair heavy pajamas  
1 bathrobe  
14 pair underwear  
1 warm jacket  
1 pair of gym shoes  
1 pair casual shoes  
1 beach robe  
1 shower basket

### **Mandatory for boys:**

4 kipot  
3 pair tzitzit

## Shabbat

### Boys

4 white shirts with collar  
3 navy blue pants (no denim)  
1 pair Shabbat shoes

### Girls

2 white blouses  
2 navy blue skirts (no denim)  
3 dresses or skirts with tops  
1 pair Shabbat shoes  
No FlipFlops

*Boys must wear white shirts and blue pants throughout Shabbat; girls must wear blue skirts and white blouses on Friday night, but may wear dresses or outfits of other colors on Shabbat day.*

## LINENS

3 fitted bed sheets  
3 bath towels  
3 top sheets  
3 hand towels  
3 pillow cases  
3 wash cloths  
2 heavy blankets  
4 pool towels

## TOILETRIES

Soap and soap box  
Shampoo  
Toothbrush/toothpaste  
Comb and brush  
Plastic drinking cup  
1 box facial tissues  
Baby powder (optional)

## MISCELLANEOUS

1 flashlight and batteries  
1 clip on fan  
1 pair Tefillin (boys)  
1 canteen with belt or shoulder strap  
1 sleeping bag  
1 backpack/overnight bag  
1 laundry bag **with name on bag**  
Calamine or Caladryl lotion  
Extra pair of glasses  
stamps, pen, writing paper

## ADDITIONAL ITEMS FOR MACHAL

Sturdy, ankle hiking shoes  
Sunglasses  
2 work outfits (comfortable and loose slacks that will last through wear & tear)

### Tzniut/Modesty:

Cap sleeves, sleeveless tops, crop tops, scoop and v-neck tops are not acceptable. Tight or form fitting clothing is not appropriate for any camper. Girls' skirts and shorts must cover the knees while sitting, **yoga pants and leggings are not permitted**. Clothing with inappropriate language or innuendo may not be worn.

**NOTE: Despite current fashion trends, no child may wear any shirt that leaves the midriff or waist exposed at any time. Parents are strongly urged not to purchase or send these shirts, as campers wearing these shirts will be sent to change clothes.**

### PLEASE NOTE: □

- Please have your child's name marked on each item that he/she brings to camp.
- For safety reasons, campers are required to use sheets and regular blankets. Sleeping bags are to be used only for the Macheneh Chutz (overnight trip) outside of camp only. **No child may use a sleeping bag in the bunks.**
- Camp Moshava assumes no responsibility for wear and tear, loss or damage to camper's clothing or other personal effects.
- Laundry is sent out every other week during camp.
